

Report of CCTCC Current Activities

Finances:

- As of March 31, 2018, our hosting agreement with HCCC has concluded. The transition has been smooth, although there are still a few pieces that need to be addressed. On April 17, 2018 the auditors will be reviewing HCCC's books including the CCTCC project. Audited Financial Statements will be provided to the executive when they become available.

Metrics:

- Metrics have been received from both Trialtrove and IQVIA. Preliminary analysis has been completed and high level data will be provided to the executive at the April 17 meeting.
- We have also inquired with Trialtrove about expanding the focus to include the 21 countries for which we are receiving data from IQVIA (currently only 5 countries were provided). In addition, they are able to provide some patient number metrics but this was beyond the scope of our contract.
- A project proposal is being developed, as previously discussed at the March 14 executive meeting, to request additional funds for the metrics initiative.
- We are currently in discussion with N2 as to whether it would be possible to obtain Metrics from their members. The focus is on ensuring that if the project is undertaken there is value for both the members and the CCTCC.

Investment Case:

- The data in the investment case is currently being updated to reflect the most recent data available. We have been able to update sections of the investment case with the metrics data received. In addition, we are looking at redesigning the presentation to make it more user friendly and attractive. Please see the proposal within the April 17, 2018 Executive package

CCTAM:

- Database updates are currently being undertaken to ensure maximum usability
- There continues to be interest in the database and opportunities for expansion continue to arise.
- The content of the new splash page has been inputted. A review is being completed and as soon as it is finished the website will be ready for launch

Strategic Planning:

- There have been several conversations with Optimus SBR over the past several weeks to provide context and clarifications regarding the needs of the CCTCC in developing a Business case and the services that were being proposed. An updated proposal is included in the package for discussion and decision by the executive.

mCTA:

- Discussions are ongoing with Pharma and Sites who are interested in adopting the mCTA. We are working on confirming members of the review committee which will ensure the continued relevance of the document.

Website Update:

- The prototype for the new CCTCC website has been received and is currently under review. The content remains the same, the review is just to ensure the accuracy of the transferred information and whether any changes are necessary.
