

CCTAM Principles for partnerships:

- Benefits the CCTAM in terms of fulfillment of mandate and especially data collection and data set comprehensiveness, communication and promotion efforts
- Does not violate CCTAM user agreement and fundamental principles, and more specifically:
 - the data is used for the purposes of attracting more CTs to Canada and making their start-up and conduct more effective and efficient
 - conditions of data being provided to the CCTAM, i.e. members retain control of the data they have contributed and their data can't be shared with other databases without their consent
- Promotes Canada as a preferred destination for CTs
- Enables CT capacity creation, development and maintenance in Canada
- Has minimal to none negative implications
