

What is success for the Canadian Clinical Trials Asset Map (CCTAM)?

Year 1, end of 2015

Overall:

- The CCTAM has been launched
- Work started on Rx&D member companies' clinical trial sites/investigator agreements including a clause re adding their data to the CCTAM

Communications and Outreach:

- The CCTAM's full website is about to be launched
- Comprehensive Provincial Outreach is underway
- The British Columbia and New Brunswick provincial partnerships are producing results
- CCTAM outreach (via meetings and conference demos/presentations, poster presentation, social media) is underway

Data and Development:

- Institutional, Clinical Research Organizations (CROs), Site Management Organizations (SMOs) and disease networks (which we currently lack with some minor exceptions) data start being populated (5%)
- More site and investigators data is being added (over 1000 assets)
- Already populated (before the launch) CCTAM data assets create member accounts and verify their data
- Future functionality development plans are underway

Year 2, end of 2016

Overall:

- The CCTAM has started to become the first resource used by Rx&D member companies when locating investigators and sites for clinical trials in Canada
- Advance the work on Rx&D member companies' clinical trial sites/investigator agreements including a clause re adding their data to the CCTAM

Communications and Outreach:

- Provincial Outreach is completed; clear outcomes regarding the possibility of other provincial partnerships (than BC and NB)
- CCTAM outreach (via meetings and conference demos/presentations, poster presentation, social media) continues as needed
- CCTAM's website continues to provide new and relevant content
- CCTAM has online and social media presence

Data and Development:

- Institutional, Clinical Research Organizations (CROs), Site Management Organizations (SMOs) and disease networks data is being populated (40%)
- More site and investigators data continues to be populated (70%)
- Already populated CCTAM data assets create update their assets
- The CCTAM discussion forum functionality is used by the CCTAM members
- CCTAM members provide suggestion for future functionality development
- Further functionality development is underway

Year 3, end of 2017

Overall:

- The CCTAM is preferred resource used by Rx&D member companies when locating investigators and sites for clinical trials in Canada
- Rx&D member companies' clinical trial sites/investigator agreements include a clause re adding their data to the CCTAM

Communications and Outreach:

- Provincial Outreach maintenance, e.g. by involving provincial stakeholders on the CCTAM working groups, etc.
- CCTAM outreach (via meetings and conference demos/presentations, poster presentation, social media) continues as needed
- CCTAM's website continues to provide new and relevant content
- CCTAM has perceptible online and social media presence

Data and Development:

- The CCTAM's assets includes close to 90% of all clinical trial sites in Canada
- The CCTAM's assets includes close to 70% of all institutions, Clinical Research Organizations (CROs), Site Management Organizations (SMOs) and disease networks
- Already populated CCTAM data assets create update their assets
- The CCTAM discussion forum functionality is used by the CCTAM members
- CCTAM members provide suggestion for future functionality development
- Metrics implemented to measure CCTAM positive impact on clinical trials in Canada (%growth)
- Further functionality development is underway
